# Don't let your kids **SLIP AND SLIDE**

Children who do not continue to read over the summer can lose as much as three months of reading achievement.

### Did you know:

- In Idaho, low income homes average only 1 book for every 300 children. By comparison, in middle and high income homes, each child has an average of 50 books. (Book It Forward, 2014)
- Reading proficiently is the most significant indicator of academic success.
- 85% of children in the juvenile justice system are functionally illiterate.

# **Healthy Food Choices Program for Kids**

The Power of Produce (PoP) Club is a fun and exciting new children's program that will be held at the Hayden Farmers Market this summer. The program seeks to encourage children to make healthy food choices by empowering them to shop for, grow and prepare fresh fruits and vegetables.

Children between the ages of 5 - 12 are eligible to participate in the program free of charge. Upon registering, they will given a reusable shopping bag and a PoP Club button. In addition, each week club members will receive a token worth \$2 to purchase a fresh fruit, vegetable or plant at participating farmer booths



at the market, or they can choose to save their tokens to buy a larger item such as a fruit tree.

A PoP Club booth will offer interactive, age - appropriate, cooking and gardening activities for club members. Participation will be tracked in an activity "Passport"; after completing a set number of activities, the child will receive a prize.






In early 2016 the Coeur d'Alene City council voted to support the

The Memorial will be using an area that's an unused grassy knoll portion of McEuen. It's going to be a great use of that area to invite people to come in, spend some time and really enjoy the area and take time to memorialize on it as well.

Panhandle Parks Foundation, in partnership with the City of Coeur d'Alene have been raising funds for the Water Feature through donations, fundraisers and grants - no tax dollars will be used for this.

# In the words of hope from Mahatma Gandhi

## "BE THE CHANGE YOU WANT TO SEE IN THE WORLD." – TEACH YOUR CHILDREN ABOUT HUMAN RIGHTS.

When children learn and understand at a young age to respect human rights, they are more apt to grow into socially responsible citizens. It is easy to comprehend that we all have the right to access basic needs such as food, water and shelter. Yet around the world, there are children who are denied their human rights every day.

Many young girls are forced to work without the hope of an education. According to the Education for All Global Monitoring Report, there are more than 31 million girls of primary school age out of school. Of these, 17 million are never expected to enter school. (United Nations)

Everyone in the world also has the right to live without fear of violence and war. Yet for so many, it is a daily reality. Today, child soldiers, some boys as young as 8 years old, are fighting in at least 14 countries, including in suicide attacks.

Children, often abandoned, are left to survive on the streets and in unhealthy conditions. UNICEF estimates there are approximately 100 million street children worldwide with that number constantly growing. There are up to 40 million street children in Latin America, and at least 18 million in India.

Allowing children to explore global issues that affect children their own age, provides opportunities for age-appropriate action and teaches human rights that will ensure that all people are treated with dignity and equality for generations to come.



Human Rights ARE universal and should NEVER be denied. They protect us from violence and abuse and work towards the end of ignorance and hatred. Individuals trained in Mental Health First Aid can help:

- Raise awareness and encourage understanding of the ways in which one's cultural background can impact the discrimination associated with mental illness.
- · Reach out to those who suffer in silence, reluctant to seek help.





- Let students know that support is available on campus and in the community.
- Provide information on self help strategies and campus and community resources.
- Make mental health care and treatment accessible to those in need

Youth Mental Health First Aid is designed to teach parents, family members, teachers, school staff, peers, and health care personnel how to help an adolescent (age 12 - 18) who is experiencing a mental health or addiction challenge or is in crisis. Youth Mental Health First Aid is ideal for adults who regularly interact with young people. The course introduces common mental health challenges for youth, reviews typical adolescent development, and teaches a five - step action plan for how to help young people in both crisis and non - crisis situations. Topics covered include anxiety, depression, substance use, disorders in which psychosis may occur, disruptive behavior disorders (including AD/HD), and eating disorders.




